ABSTRACT

This study seeks to identify the beginnings of American interest in the Jordan River basin (Palestine and Transjordan) in the middle of the nineteenth century, which was manifested in the American Expedition that was led by Officer Lynch. This officer visited Jordan River and the Dead Sea in 1848 for economic, scientific, and religious reason. That visit was so significant because it was the first successful American expedition to the area. Lynch showed great interest in the region and recommended settling Jews in that area.
